



## Flinders University Baseball and Softball Club Behaviour Code of Conduct 2017

Flinders University Baseball and Softball Club (FUBSC) is a club for players and officials of all levels of abilities, races, religions, genders and ethnicities. As a club, FUBSC prides itself on its inclusive environment and the safety of all players and officials.

The objective of this code of conduct is to protect players and officials from harassment of physical, verbal and cyber of nature. This code of conduct will outline players and official's rights and the club's commitment to ensuring a safe environment for all who attend games, both home and away.

As a player and/or official for FUBSC you have a right to expect an environment where:

- You will be treated in a fair and friendly manner by all other club members,
- You will be able to partake in games free of disruptive behaviours including foul or abusive language, obscene gestures or socially unacceptable behaviours,
- You will not be harassed, bullied or assaulted in any way, be it physical, verbal or cyber, by any member of the club, the opposing team, officials or game day spectator.

As a player and/or official for FUBSC you will conduct yourself in an appropriate manner where:

- You will respect other players, officials and game day spectators both home and away,
- You will refrain from harassing, bullying or assaulting in anyway, be it physical, verbal or cyber, any member of the club, the opposing team, officials or game day spectators,
- You will use appropriate language, without threatening, foul or abusive content based on race, religion, gender, sexuality or individual player ability,
- You will engage in responsible consumption of alcohol when available, both at home and away games,
- You will comply with the requests of club officials and emergency services when present in the case of an emergency.
